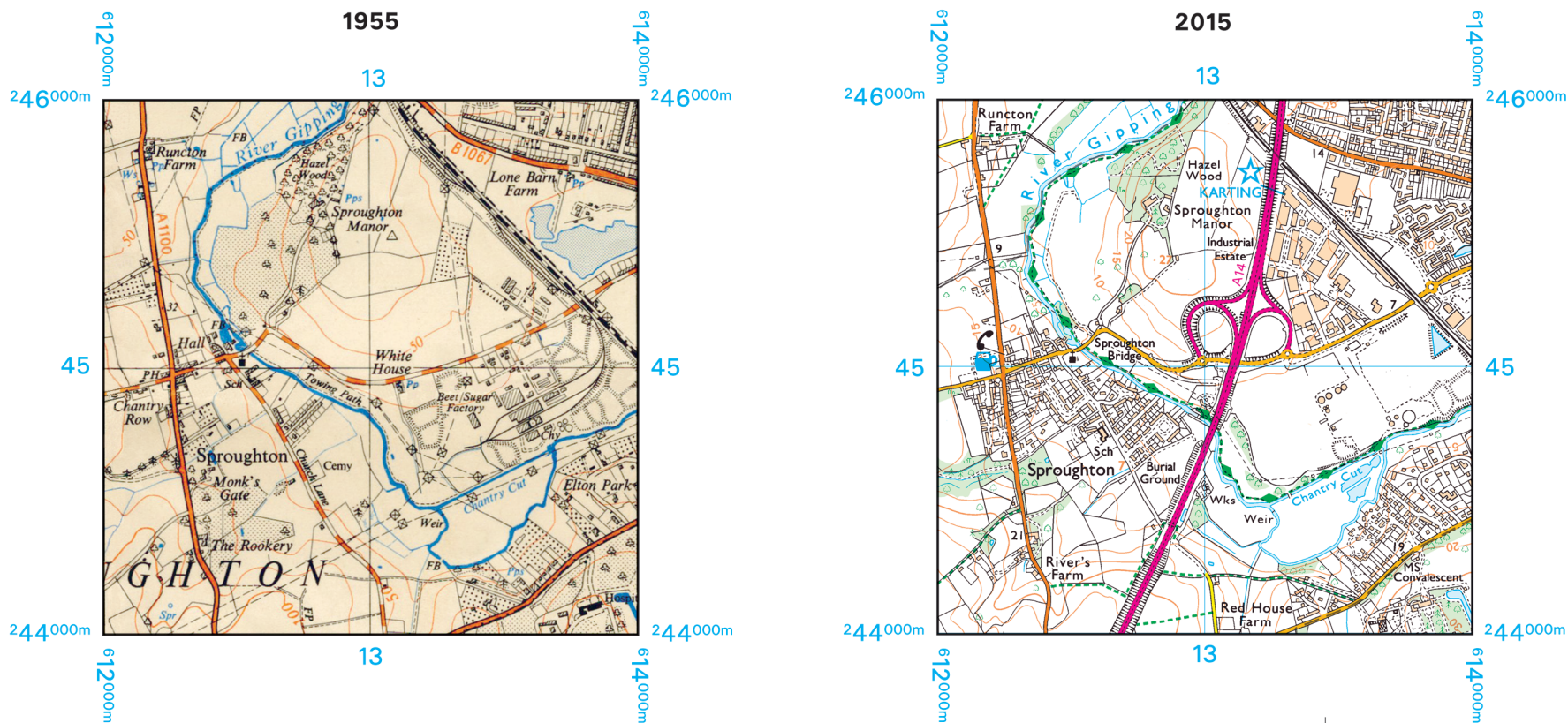
Fig. 2 – OS 1:25000 map extracts of an area in the rural-urban fringe of Ipswich for 1955 and 2015

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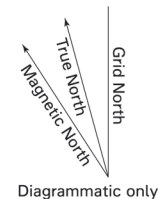
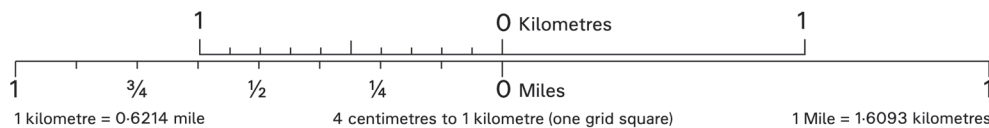

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Fig. 3 – Share of intra-regional imports of merchandise within the EU, for selected EU countries, 2014

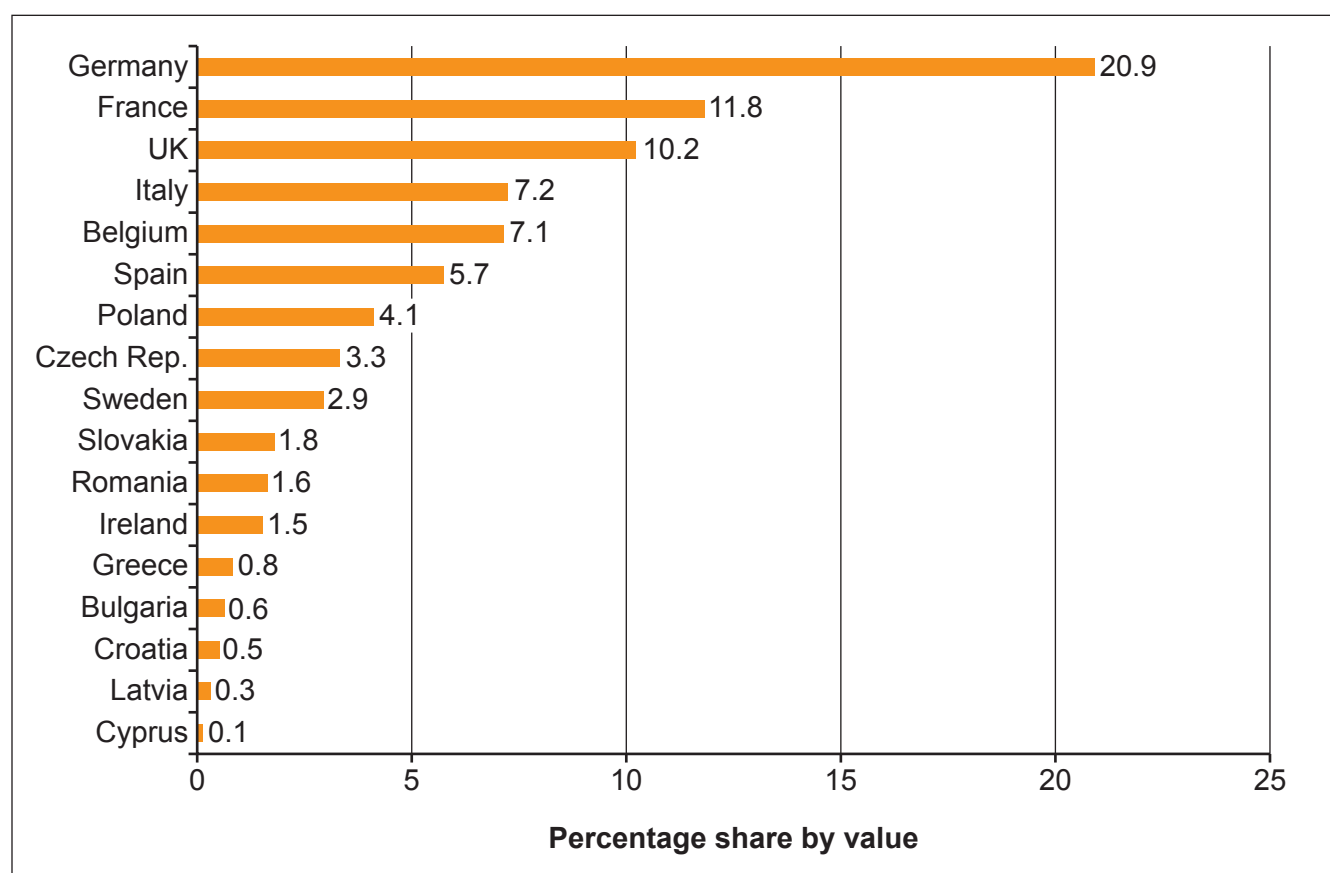
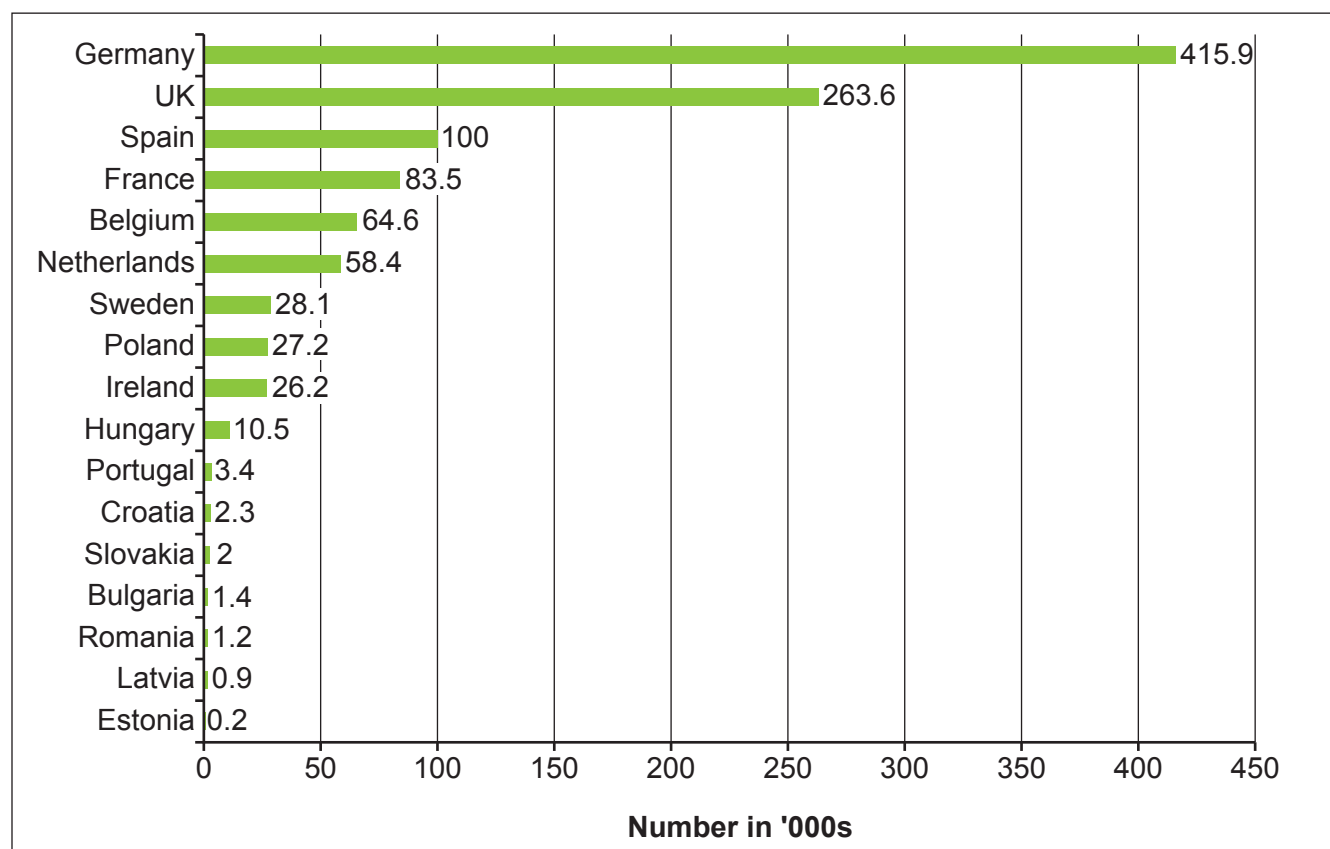


Fig. 4 – Number of intra-regional immigrants within the EU, for selected EU countries, 2014



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
