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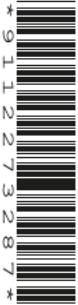

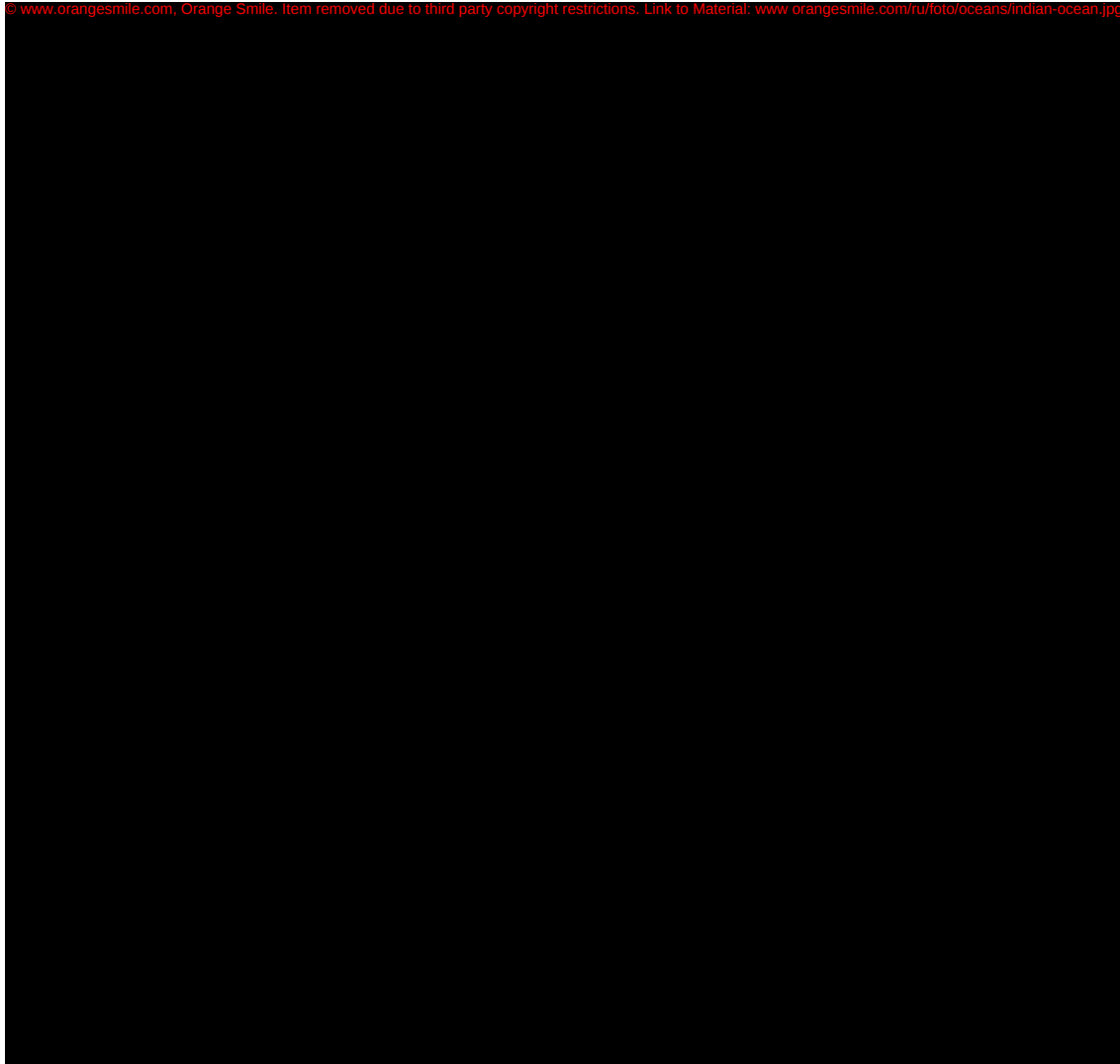

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Fig. 2 Percentage of deaths caused by air pollution in South and East Asia, 2017

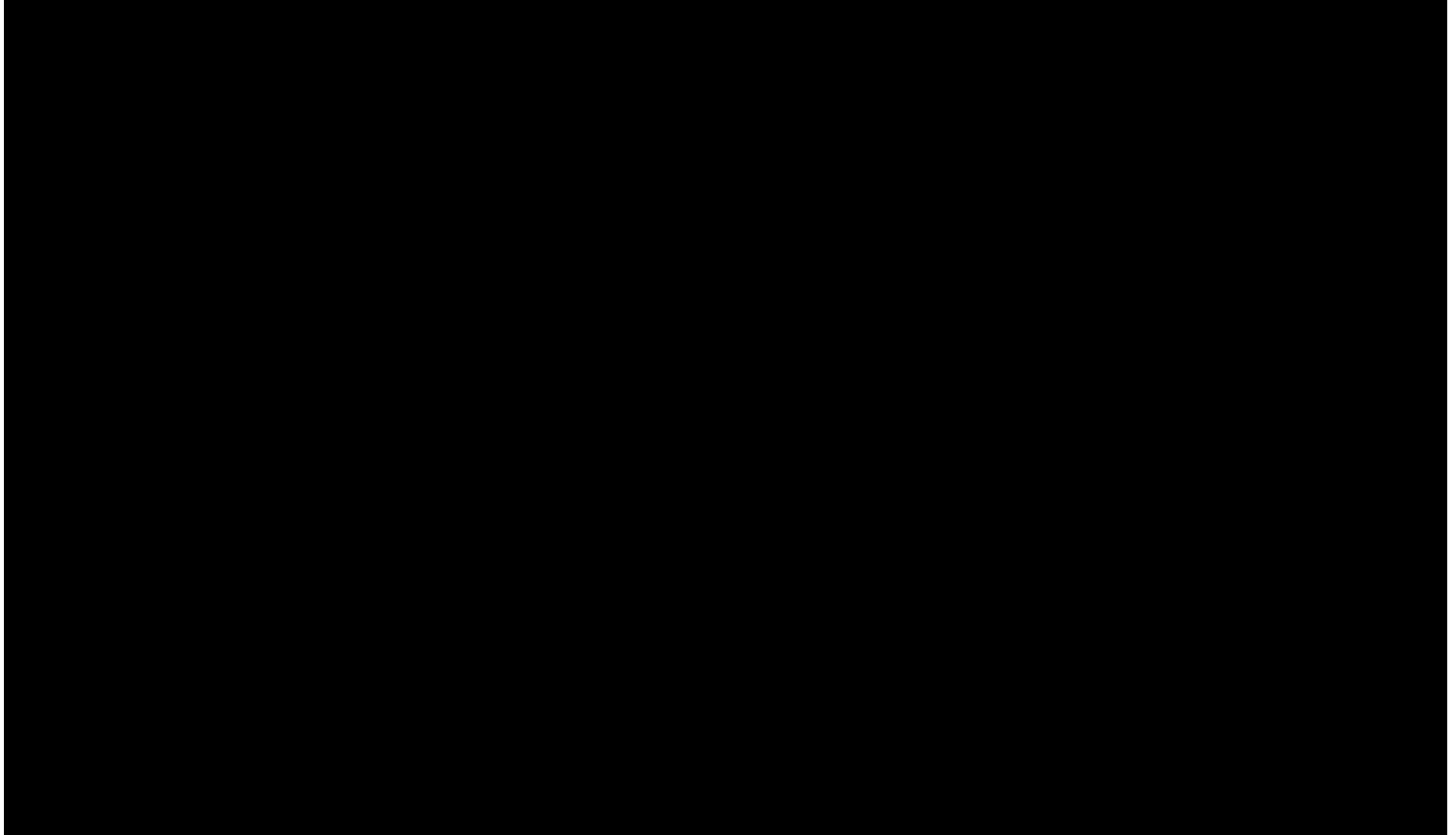
